Since the recent meetings in Colombo, Sri Lanka, DeafICC anticipate a formal announcement on Monday 29th January 2018. It is appreciated that the boards & members have been waiting patiently for the official invitation to 8 countries to participate in the DeafICC T20 World Cup 2018.

We are pleased to state that DeafICC are exploring two options to ensure that the tournament will take place in the latter part of 2018. The logistics for the tournament director, itinerary, dates, hotel bookings and venues are being finalized this week; therefore DeafICC will return to their offices on Monday 29th January 2018 to make the historic formal invitation.

It is also with intention that DeafICC will announce the (ODI/50 overs) World Cup in 2020 in the next few months as DeafICC will be able to produce questions and answers on a monthly basis. Our good DeafICC Secretary, Mr Michael Lombard, will receive enquiries and DeafICC will be able to respond accordingly.
